6/28: COYOTE CAFE: HAMBURG: The first outdoor show of the year under a big tent in back of the cafe.. It was our first show in a long time, if ever, in Hamburg in my memory. Nice crowd. Three St. Martin boxers got on the show though one bout was an intramural. With no opponents and to fill the card, team mates 70Brendon Davis faced team mate James Hollister. The youngsters showed the crowd some really good boxing skills. Brendon got a close decision, but James continues to show great improvement boxing Brendon regularly in practices. The contest was just like their practice sessions. 132Isiah Vargas made his USA Boxing debut against more experienced Lake Placid ADK Boxing's Ryan Gallagher. Isaiah showed some nice skills, but then got into a slugging match and the referee awarded the match to Gallagher. Drove there on local roads, but took the Thruway home.

7/12: JAMESTOWN RUMBLE AT THE ARENA: Ironically, this was a show in the ICE ARENA on a very hot day. Twenty-two bouts, but only two were offered St. Martin boxers. 70Brenden Davis had his pre-made bout scratched when his Cleveland opponent no showed. This left 160Paris Davis to face local JT TOP LEVEL's popular Caleb Rivera in a major bout of the night. The bout was all Paris. He kept Rivera at bay on the outside, but he also dominated with the inside action, resulting in a dominating 3-0 decision over the hometown. He won a nice belt. St. Martin contributed some of the gloves as the new promoting club was short. It was a three hour trip on the Thruway and Route 60 for the effort. Good crowd.
